

Welcome to Radnor Valley Country Club!

Getting Started:

All members and guests are required to register with a member of the professional staff or outside services staff before playing. Starting times will always be given priority for play. Individual players and twosomes are encouraged to join other players to make up a foursome. Please adhere to any tee time modifications the Golf Professional Staff may make to utilize play.

All play is required to start on the first hole on each golf course unless otherwise specifically approved by the Golf Professional staff. Reserving starting times in advance carries with it an obligation to use the time. All players must tee off at the time reserved or wait until the next available tee time opening.

Dress Code for Men:

 Proper golf attire is required at all times year-round. Shirts must have sleeves and be tucked in at all times. Hats must be worn with bill facing forward. The following are prohibited: blue jeans (either short or long pants); T-shirts; bathing suits; cut off shorts, any type of short shorts, sweat pants and any type of skin-tight clothing. With respect to the Pro Shop and patio area, no exposed bathing suits are permitted.

Dress Code for Women:

• Proper golf attire is required at all times year-round. Ladies may wear their shirts untucked and wear sleeveless shirts. The following are prohibited: blue jeans (either short or long pants); T-shirts; bathing suits; cut off shorts or any type of short shorts and short skirts, sweat pants and any type of skin-tight clothing. With respect to the Pro Shop and patio area, no exposed bathing suits are permitted.

Guest Rules:

- No Fivesomes
- Personal Push Carts are allowed, must stay 15 feet away from all greens and bunkers.
- The member is responsible for guest fees at the prevailing rates.

- Only guests, where the member has been charged a greens fee, are permitted to use the practice facilities.
- Guests may NOT use the practice facilities after play.
- Juniors are not permitted on the practice facilities or golf course before 10 am on weekends and holidays. Juniors must be 6 years of age or older to play. Contact the golf shop for more information regarding junior play.

Care For The Course:

- Repair ball marks on the putting greens.
- Replace all fairway divots and stamp firmly in place with your foot. Replacing a divot (if available) is always better than using divot fill.
- Enter and leave bunkers at the low point of the bunker.
- Use the rakes to carefully level all footprints and marks of play in the bunkers.
- Rakes are to be placed outside of all bunkers.
- Dogs and other pets are not permitted on the golf courses or practice facility.
- Avoid allowing golf clubs, golf bag, or the flagstick to fall on the putting greens.

Golf Carts:

- Cart Rule signs are located at the golf cart pick up area, #1 tee and #10 tee. It is every player's responsibility to look for the cart rules.
- If cart rules require "Cart Paths" then all four tires of the cart must remain on the cart path at all times. Occasionally, the Greens Superintendent may allow crossing on certain holes on the back nine when "Cart Paths Only" is posted. If this is allowed there will be a sign posted on or near the teeing ground for that hole. If "Scatter" is posted, then fairway driving is permitted.
- All operators of golf carts must be 16 years of age or older with a valid Drivers License.
- Carts must be kept 30 feet from greens and tees. Carts must be parked on cart paths where available.
- Carts must remain on the cart paths as all times on par three holes.
- Carts may not enter roped off areas for any reason. When reaching the green rope in the fairway, follow the direction of the arrow to the nearest cart path.
- No more than two persons are permitted to ride in a cart at any time except that a child under the age of 10 shall be permitted to ride with 2 persons, or two children under the age 10 shall be permitted to ride with one person (subject to the rules concerning the times when children are permitted to be on the golf course).
